Malik: O' You who believe! Seek My help with patience and prayer: surely, Allah is with those who are patient.

Pickthall: O ye who believe! Seek help in steadfastness, and prayer. Lo! Allah is with the steadfast.

Yusuf Ali: O ye who believe! seek help with patient perseverance and prayer: for Allah is with those who patiently persevere. ¹⁵⁷

Transliteration: Ya ayyuha allatheena amanoo istaAAeenoo bialssabri waalssalati inna Allaha maAAa alssabireena

Khatab:

O believers! Seek comfort in patience and prayer. Allah is truly with those who are patient.

157 - See ii. 45 and n. An additional meaning implied in sabr is self-restraint. Haqqani defines it in his Tafsir as following Reason and restraining Fear, Anger, and Desire. What can be a higher reward for patience, perseverance, self-restraint and constancy than that God should be with us? For this promise opens the door to every kind of spiritual well-being.
