Malik: who are punctual in the payment of Zakah (charity),

Pickthall: And who are payers of the poor due;

Yusuf Ali: Who are active in deeds of charity;

Transliteration: Waallatheena hum lilzzakati faAAiloon

Khatab:

those who pay alms-tax;1

### Author Comments

1 - Lit., "working for" or "active in behalf of [inner] purity", which is the meaning of zakah in this context (Zamakhshari; the same interpretation has been advanced by Abu Muslim).

Zakâh means purification and growth. Paying alms-tax and charity are forms of purifying one's wealth.
