

## Surah 55. Ar-Rahman

Asad: In [each of] these two [gardens] two springs will flow.<sup>24</sup>

Malik: In both of them there will be two flowing springs.

Pickthall: Wherein are two fountains flowing.

Yusuf Ali: In them (each) will be two Springs flowing (free);<sup>5206</sup>

Transliteration: Feehima AAaynani tajriyani

Khatab:

In each ?Garden? will be two flowing springs.

### Author Comments

24 - The "two springs" of paradise call to mind the "two seas" spoken of in {18:60-61}, which, according to Baydawi, symbolize the two sources or streams of knowledge accessible to man: the one obtained through the observation and intellectual analysis of external phenomena ('ilm az-zahir), and the other through inward, mystic insight ('ilm al-batin).

5206 - Two Springs, for the same reasons as there will be two Gardens. See last note.
