Asad: with goblets, and ewers, and cups filled with water from unsullied springs⁶

Malik: with goblets, shining beakers and cups of pure wine,

Pickthall: With bowls and ewers and a cup from a pure spring

Yusuf Ali: With goblets (shining) beakers and cups (filled) out of clear-flowing fountains:

Transliteration: Biakwabin waabareeqa wakasin min maAAeenin

Khatab:

with cups, pitchers, and a drink ?of pure wine? from a flowing stream,

6 - This is evidently a symbolic allusion to the imperishable quality - the eternal youthfulness, as it were - of all the experiences in the state described as "paradise". (See also next two notes.)
