

Surah 56. Al-Waqi'a

Asad: will indeed be gathered together at an appointed time on a Day known [only to God]:

Malik: shall certainly be brought together on an appointed time of a known Day.

Pickthall: Will all be brought together to the tryst of an appointed day.

Yusuf Ali: "All will certainly be gathered together for the meeting appointed for a Day Well-known. **5246**

Transliteration: LamajmooAAoona ila meeqaati yawmin maAAaloomin

Khatab:

will surely be gathered together for the appointed Day.

Author Comments

5246 - In xxvi, 38 (see n. 3159) the phrase "a day well-known" is used for a solemn day of festival, when the multitude of people gather together. The Day of Judgment is such a day in the supreme sense of the word.
