

## Surah 56. Al-Waqi'a

Asad: [he, too, will be welcomed into paradise with the words,] "Peace be unto thee [that art] of those who have attained to righteousness!"

Malik: he is greeted with salutation: "Peace be upon you," from those of the right hand.

Pickthall: Then (the greeting) "Peace be unto thee" from those on the right hand

Yusuf Ali: (For him is the salutation) "Peace be unto thee" from the Companions of the Right Hand. **5270**

Transliteration: Fasal<sup>am</sup>un laka min ash<sup>ab</sup>i alyameeni

Khatab:

then ?they will be told,? "Greetings to you from the people of the right."

### Author Comments

5270 - In lvi. 26 above the salutation of "Peace, Peace!" is addressed to those Nearest to Allah. Here we learn that it is also addressed to the Companions of the Right Hand. Both are in Gardens of Bliss; only the former have a higher Dignity than the latter.
