

Surah 70. Al-Ma'arij

Asad: [It will take place] on a Day when the sky will be like molten lead,

Malik: On that Day, the sky shall become like molten brass

Pickthall: The day when the sky will become as molten copper,

Yusuf Ali: The Day that the sky will be like molten brass **5681**

Transliteration: Yawma takoonu alssamao kaalmuhli

Khatab:

On that Day the sky will be like molten brass

Author Comments

5681 - Cf. xviii. 29 (where the wrong-doer will have a drink like melted brass in Hell); and xlv. 45, (where his food will be like molten brass). Here the appearance of the sky is compared to molten brass, or, as some understand it, like the dregs of oil. What is conveyed by the metaphor is that the beautiful blue sky will melt away.
