96.1 Read! In the name of your Rabb Who created

96.14 Does he not know that Allah is observing all things?

96.15 Nay! Let him know that if he does not stop, We will drag him by the forelock,

96.16 a lying, sinful forelock.

96.17 So let him call his supporters for help,

96.18 We too shall call the guards of hell to deal with him.

96.19 Nay! Do not obey him! Prostrate yourself and bring yourself closer to your Rabb.
